INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Nutrition Working Group Intern will conduct a literature review on the topic of obesity in low income settings. The literature review will provide the CORE Nutrition Working Group members with a current picture of what is being done in this field and help them to identify gaps and possibilities for further action. Areas within this topic that will need to be addressed include:

- The prevalence of obesity and depth of the problem (what, where, when)
- Causes of obesity in low-income settings (why)
- Programs and policies to address obesity (how, who)

General responsibilities will include, but not be limited to the following:

Literature Review

- Develop an annotated bibliography which provides a list and brief description of articles, reports, books, thesis, and other documents related to the topic (Deliverable).
- Develop a literature review that includes: (Deliverable)
 - Areas of consensus and dissent on this topic
 - Gaps and oversights
 - Needs for further research
 - Trends, themes, approaches, methodologies, theories and frames of analysis
 - Only include articles within the past 10 years

REQUIREMENTS

- Education in nutrition, or nutrition related field.
- Graduate student preferred.
- Interest/experience in international development issues, particularly global health and nutrition.
- Experience in Microsoft Office software.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Ability to multi-task and manage multiple deadlines.
- Must have the ability to work under pressure with flexibility in a team setting.
- Fluency in English is required. Knowledge of French and/or Spanish helpful.

Only candidates who are eligible to work in the United States will be considered. Relocation package is not available.
