

CGPP Kenya and Somalia
Weekly Project Implementation Updates
May 14-20, 2018

1.1 AFP surveillance & case detection

- **Marsabit County:** Community Mobilizers conducted AFP active case finding at Liban Fayo Village and visited 20HH. No AFP case found.
- **Turkana County:** CMs conducted AFP active case search in 19 border catchment areas; no AFP case reported.
- **Garissa County:** CMs visited 16 villages for social mobilization & AFP case search.
- **Wajir county:** 9 villages reached for active case search by the community mobilizers.
- **Mandera County:** Community sensitization on AFP case detection conducted in 6 Health facilities with the participation of 90 community elders, 6 CMs, & 6 HCWs. Active case search for AFP by 22 CMs within the week. No suspected AFP cases reported.
- **Lower Juba:** 9 CMs and 35 CHVs carried out 695 HH visit to support AFP case search detection messages. No AFP case detected.

1.2 Strengthening Routine Immunization

- **Dhobley, Somalia:** EPI outreach session within Dhobley town & Mobile clinic session to Deg elema, a total of 207 children vaccinated with 3 zero doses (newborns).
- **Gedo region:** OJT for health facility staff on community-based AFP surveillance, RI & disease surveillance using CGPP manuals at Elwak district.
- **Garissa County:** supported 2 HFs to conduct 4 outreach sessions, vaccinated 84 U5s.
- **Wajir county:** supported 5 outreach sites in the project areas and vaccinated 97 children.
- **Marsabit County:** Supported immunization defaulter tracing for 28 children in Butiye and Golole villages on 16th -17th May 2018 respectively
- **Mandera County:** 12 outreach sessions supported, vaccinating a total of 353 children.
- **Wajir county:** Synchronization of outreach services done between Gerille Kenya and Gerille Somalia in which measles cases reported on Somalia side

1.3 Cross-Border Coordination

- **Somalia:** CGPP project team held a meeting with the Jubaland MOH team led by regional MoH director general to discuss on the upcoming Joint cross-border workshop planned for Kismayo on August 2018. Also on the upcoming Joint cross-border health coordination meeting between Kenya, Ethiopia, and Somalia due to the recent cVDPV2 outbreak in the horn of Africa region on June 2018 in Kenya.
- **Garissa:** Internal cross-border health committee meeting held in Garissa on 17th May 2018, attended by 3 ScMoH and 3 county officials. The team reviewed the recommendations and action points of Wajir meeting as well as planning for the upcoming SIA and targeting the special population of Hamey and Bulogolol villages.

1.4 SIA

- **Kenya (all Counties):** No SIAs activities in all counties in Kenya
- **Somalia (Gedo and Lower Juba):** No SIA conducted during this week.

1.5 Social Mobilization

- **Gedo, Somalia:** Mother to Mother (M2M) awareness sessions in Belet-Hawo and Elwak districts reaching 40 Mothers.
- **Garissa:** CMs visited 16 villages social mobilization for AFP case search and reached a total of 8,500 persons.

- **Mandera:** Social mobilization supported 12 border villages for RI outreach services with approximate populations of 1350 persons reached.
- **Lower Juba, Somalia:** 6 CMs conducted 2 community dialogue sessions on RI and prevention of AWD at Dhobley, reached 486 beneficiaries.

1.6 Effective partnerships/Meetings

- **Kenya:**
 - ✓ The supported SIA feedback meeting in Kamukunji sub-county meeting by sub-county health management together with 5 community health teams.
 - ✓ The Secretariat participated in the 24th HOA partners and Tripartite Country meeting held yesterday in Nairobi.
 - ✓ Secretariat participated in the weekly EOC meeting
- **Somalia:**
 - ✓ CGPP ARC team met the Regional MOH team at Kismayu for project review. Discussed how regional team can support the project regularly through support supervision.
 - ✓ Developed TOR for Regional MOH team Joint support supervision for health & Polio Project at Afmadow district. The Joint supervision will start from Thursday 24th May 2018.

1.7 Training, Workshops, and conferences

- Disease surveillance training for 5 high-risk Counties by CDC (Attended by Somane)

1.8 Security situation and other challenges.

- **Insecurity:** The security situation is still tense along the Kenya-Somalia border, all aid agencies have minimized their travels outside towns. NO incidence reported this week.
- **Lower Juba:** Flash floods are still causing more displacement, especially after the Lagdera plain flooding to low lying villages settlements.
