

Key Highlights of Week

- Three (3) new cVDPV3 were reported this week from Somalia. One (1) case was isolated from Kismayu in South Zone and two (2) cases came from Mahaday District in Central Zone

Objective 1: Build effective partnerships between agencies

CORE Group secretariat and Wajir Polio project Officer took part in mapping out border settlements, the point of interest and IDP camps with 15 KM of the Kenya Somalia /Kenya Ethiopia border. Surveillance and District Public health Nurse from Mandera, Garissa, and Wajir were invited too in Wajir by the WHO HoA Office.

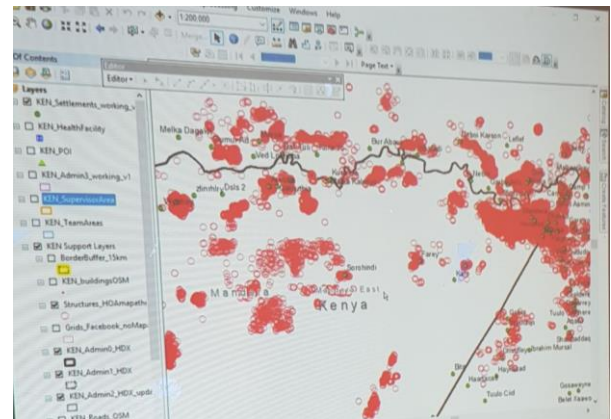


Fig. 1: County participants during the mapping of settlements and point of interest along Kenya/Somalia Ethiopia Border.

Objective 2: Strengthen routine immunization systems

Outreach Services

A total of 22 outreach sessions conducted in CGPP supported area of Lamu, Garissa, Mandera, Wajir, and Middle Gedo area in the Jubaland State of Somalia. Sixteen (73%) out of the 22 outreach sessions were supported by the CGPP partners.

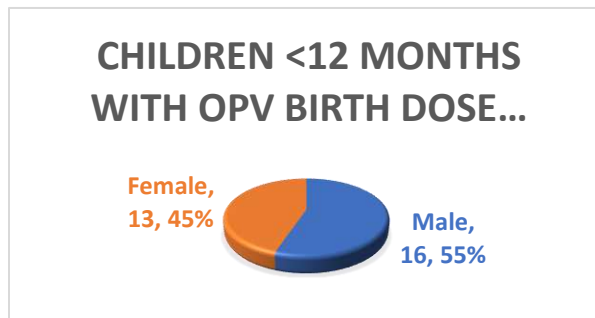


Fig.2 : Children < 12 Months given OPV birth Dose

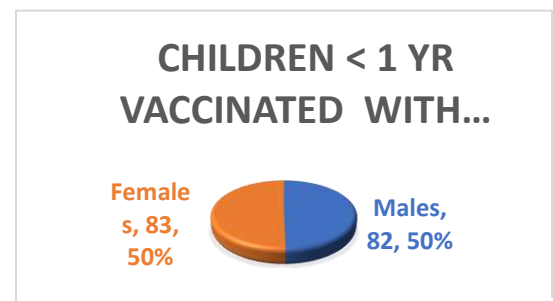


Fig.3: Children < Vaccinated with OPV 3

During the outreach sessions, a total of 550 children < 12 months were vaccinated with various antigens. Four hundred and forty (80%) of the children were vaccinated in North Horr and Moyale (Marsabit County). Twenty-nine children (5%) out of the 550 were vaccinated with OPV 0 (birth dose) as shown in fig 2 above. One hundred and sixty-five (30%) of the children out of the 550 were vaccinated with OPV3. The proportion of males vaccinated with OPV 3 were 82 (16%) while 83 (15%) were females as indicated in Fig. 3 above.

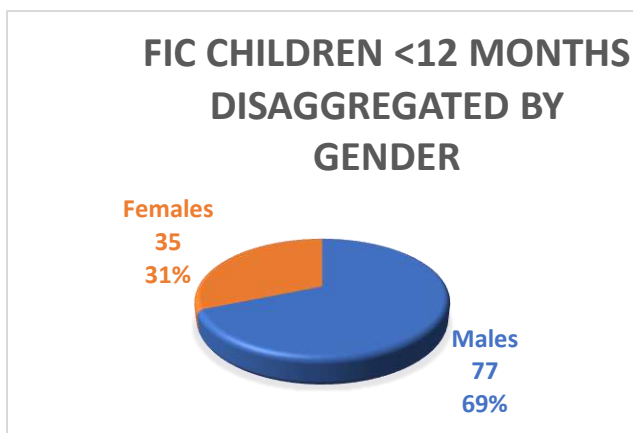


Fig. 4: Fully immunized children < 12 months

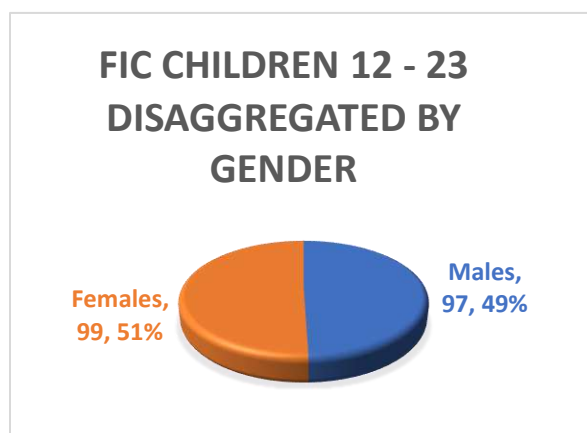


Fig.5: Fully immunized (FIC) children 12-23 months

According to Fig.4 above, 112 children < 12 months were recorded as being fully immunized out of which 35 (31%) were females while 77 (69%) were males. The total number of children recorded as FIC under the age category of 12-23 months were 196 out of which 99 (51%) were males and 97 (49%) being females as per Fig. 5 above.

Fifty (50) children were recorded as zero doses, 24 (48%) were males while 26 (52%) were females. The highest number of zero dose was reported in Mandera 47 (94%) out of the 50 reported.

Forty-eight (48) community mobilizers took part in the social mobilization activities which took place at the 7 reported CGPP supported areas. A total of 8,956 Households were visited, 44,919 families visited and 8,593 children <5 years were reached routine immunization and surveillance messages. Also, the CMs were able to conduct 204 group meetings, 1,858 one on one contact and 135 social mobilization meetings were carried out along the border and nomadic settlements.

Defaulter tracing

Community mobilizers from 7 (89%) out of the 8 Counties/regions which reported in week 40 managed to trace 1,654 children who had defaulted Immunization session. Wajir Community Mobilizers were able to trace 1,543 (93%) of the children who had defaulted immunization during the reporting week while in Turkana County defaulter tracing was not conducted.

A total of 28 new linkages (AWD referral Middle Shebella & Nutrition intervention Wajir) were formed.

Objective 3: Support supplemental polio immunization activities

The CGPP partners in the Jubaland state of Somalia participated in the SIA Conducted in lower and Middle Gedo. The type of support which they offered to the MOH to ensure the success of the SIAs were; provision of special teams along the border/nomadic population, training, social mobilization, technical and logistic support.

The children < 5yrs targetted in the lower and Middle Gedo were 97,497 out of which 85,346 (88%) were reached during the SIA as per the administrative data. Five thousand and sixty-four (6%) of the children were vaccinated at the transit points. The lower Gedo target was 54,897, and they managed to vaccinate 55,886 (102%) while the Middle Shelle target was 42,600 and they managed to vaccinate 29,460 (69%). CGPP staff took part in the Independent monitoring and results will be shared in the next reporting week.

In the two supported area of Lower and Middle Gedo, the vaccinating team managed to visit 18,556 (98%) HH out of the targeted 18,900. In this activity, 183 male social mobilizers were used.

Active case search Visits using ODK Integrated Support Supervisory Checklist 2018

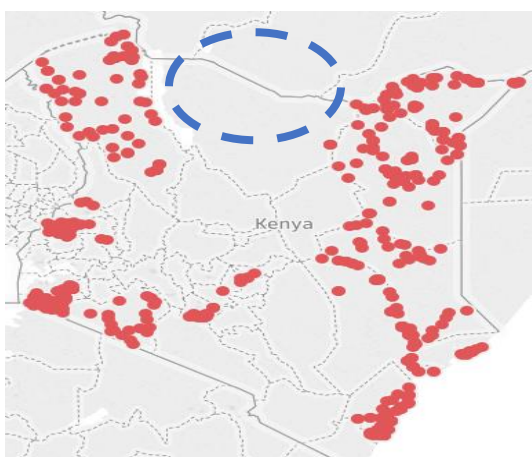


Fig.7: Past 1 Month, 01 - 30 Sept. 2018

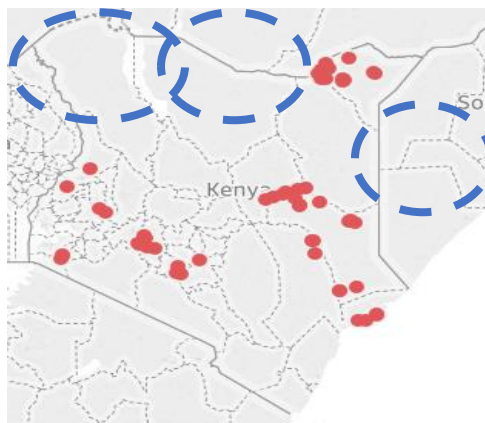



Fig.8: Past 1 week, 1st – 7th October 2018.

Integrated Support supervision (ISS) was carried out in 5 CGPP supported areas (Turkana, Mandera, Wajir, Garissa, and Lamu) using ODK in September 2018. In the last one week (1-7 October) supervision using ODK was carried out only in the 3 supported CGPP areas (Mandera, Garissa, and Lamu). It is worth mentioning that no Integrated support supervision using ODK took place in Marsabit County. The secretariate has digitized the ISS tool and will be rolling it out to the Somalia team the next one week. A total of 32 facilities (13 High P, 12 Medium and 7 Low) priority.

Fifty-seven (57) community mobilizers were engaged in active case search took part during the active case search in the CGPP supported areas. A total of 11,510 households were visited and 61,012 persons (Male 22,001 (36%) and Females 39,011 (64%) were reached with Routine Immunization and Surveillance messages. One case of suspected AFP was found in Lower Gedo during the active case search. Capacity building on Routine Immunization and Surveillance was conducted in 3 of the CGPP target area and targeting 138 persons (Males 114 (83%) and females 24 (17%).
