

Highlights

- No new human cases of cVDPV 2 or 3 were confirmed this week. Three new cVDPV2 isolates were found in the environment in Somalia this week. The total number of human cases remains 12, all of which are in Somalia; five cases of cVDPV2, 6 cases of cVDPV3 and one case of a child with coinfection of cVDPV2 and 3.
- Kenya conducted the fourth round of bivalent oral polio vaccine (bOPV) campaigns from the 20—24 October in 12 high-risk countries bordering Somalia and Ethiopia. This campaign targeted 2,875,546 children under the age of five.
- CGPP provided technical and logistic support in the border and hard to reach areas during the bOPV campaign through the provision of extra special teams for temporary transit vaccination posts and nomadic pastoralist, social mobilization and IEC materials.
- World Polio Day was commemorated last week in Kenya and Somalia with television and radio roundtables, press releases, joint statements, and social media activities.
- CGPP conducted Independent Monitoring (IM) and LQAS survey in the border counties of Garissa, Lamu, Wajir, and Mandera from Oct 25-27, 2018.

- CGPP provided technical support to WHO/MOH Somalia on microplanning for the upcoming bOPV campaign in Somaliland, and South-Central Somalia through the deployment of CGPP Deputy Director deployed to Somaliland and South-Central to support WHO/MOH in the exercise.

Number of children < 12 Months reached by County, N=1,183

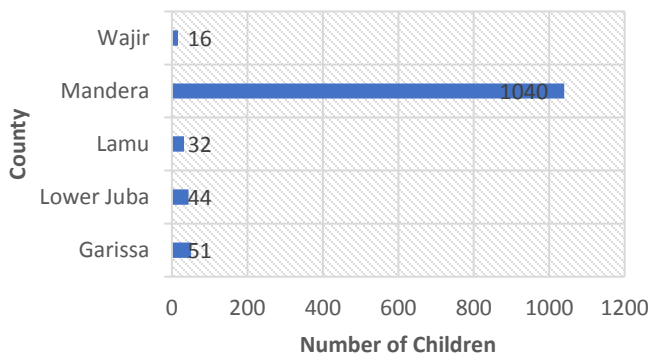


Fig 1: Number of Children < 1Yrs reached during the outreach Session, N=1,183

The number of OPV 3 children < 1 years vaccinated by gender N=1,125

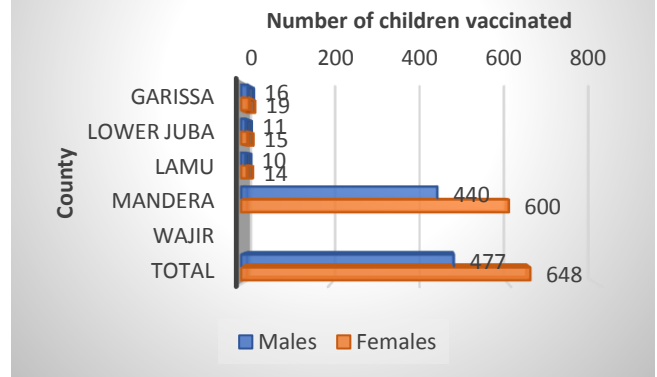


Fig.2: Children <12 Months vaccinated with OPV 3

Twenty-six outreach services conducted in five (63%) of the CGPP supported county Garissa (Dadaab, Fafi, Hulugho), Lamu (Lamu East), Lower Juba (Afmadhow, Badhadhe), Mandera (Banissa, Mandera East, North, South) and Wajir (Wajir, East, North & South) conducted outreach. Twenty four (92%) of the outreach supported by the CGPP partners operating on the ground and a total of 1,183 children < 1 year were reached with various antigens according to Fig. 1 above.

According to fig. 2, the total number of children < 1 year vaccinated by gender were 1,125 out of which the males were 477 (42%), and the females were 648 (58%). The highest number of children 1,040 (92%) were seen in Mandera county while the lowest number of children reached during the outreach sessions was in Lamu 24 (2%).

Fully Immunized Children < 12 Months segregated by Gender

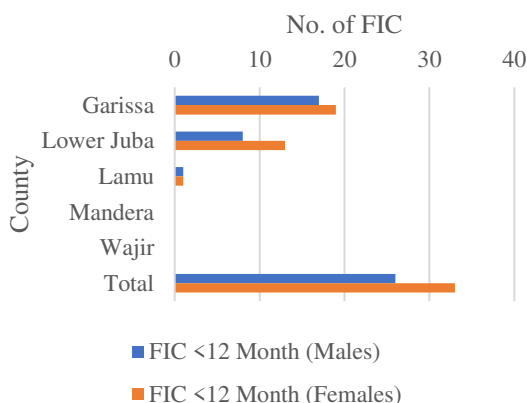


Fig.3 : FIC < 12 Months

Fully Immunized Children 12-23 Months segregated by Gender

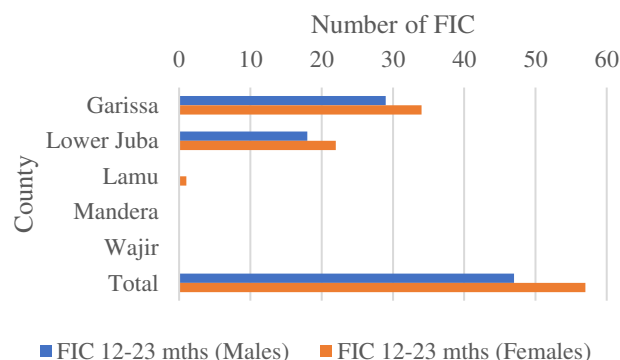


Fig.4 : FIC 12 -23 Months

According to Fig.3 above, 59 children < 12 months recorded as being fully immunized out of which 26 (44%) were males while 33 (56%) were females. The total number of children registered as FIC under the age category of 12 - 23 months were 104 out of which 47 (45%) were males while 57 (55%) were females as per Fig.4 above. More females children are finishing their immunization schedule than males based on the above findings.

Eleven children (Garissa 3 (27%), Lower Juba 5 (45%) and Lamu 3 (27%)) recorded as Zero doses.

Seventy-four (74) community mobilizers from the 8 CGPP supported area reported participating in community mobilization activities. A total of 3,579 HH visited, the CMs were also able to reach 16,936 families reached, 3,008 children <5 years reached with routine immunization and surveillance messages. It is also worth mentioning that the CMs were able to conduct 1,655 one on one contact, 130 group meetings and 209 social mobilization activities were carried out along the border and nomadic settlements

Defaulter tracing

Community Mobilizers conducted defaulter tracing from 7 (88%) out of the 9 Counties/Regions which reported this week and managed to trace 203 children who had defaulted Immunization. The highest number of children 53 (26%) were traced in Wajir County, and no tracing was done in Kamukunji sub-county.

According to table 2 above, No CBHC meeting took place in Mandera, Marsabit & Nairobi. A total of 30 CBHC meetings took place in the remaining areas. During the reporting week, 5 (56%) out of the 9 CGPP supported area reported having 13 active Community Based committee. The CBHC meeting takes place on a monthly basis according to 4 (44%) of the counties reported. Seventeen special vaccination identified although only 13 (76%) being functional. Worth mentioning that 18 vaccination transit route was in place during the reporting week.

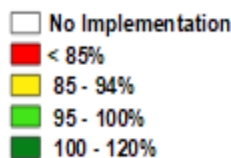

Active case search Visits using ODK Integrated Support Supervisory Checklist 2018

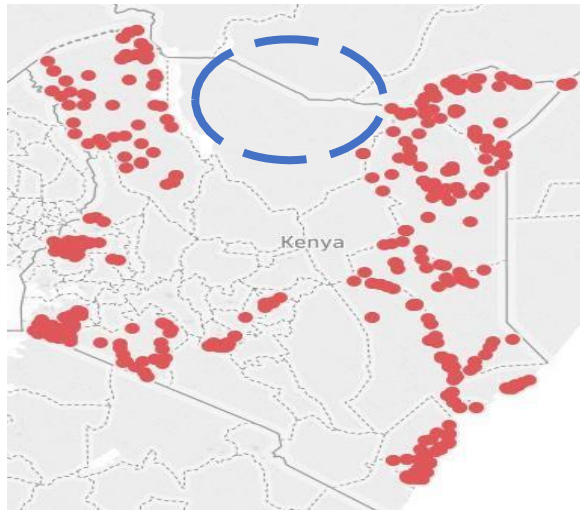


Fig.8: Past 1 Month, 01 - 30 Sept.

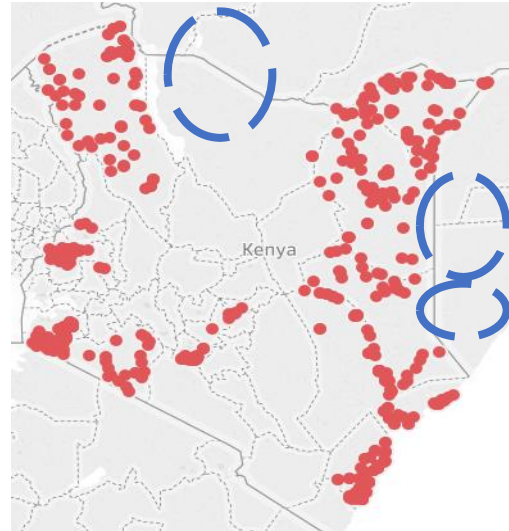



Fig.9: Past 3 week, 1st – 28th October 2018.

Integrated Support supervision (ISS) was carried out in 7 out of the of 8 reported GCPP supported area of Turkana, Garissa, Marsabit, Mandera, Wajir, Garissa and Lamu County using ODK in the first four weeks (01-28) October 2018. A total of 197 facilities visited, and it is worth noting that no Integrated support supervision using took place in Nairobi County (Kamukunji).

The digitized Integrated support supervision (ISS) tool to be used by the Somalia team has been finalized and deployed on the ONA platform and shared with the program officer from Lower Juba and Gedo region.

Sixty-three (63) community mobilizers took part during the active case search and managed to visit a total of 2,628 households, 8,974 persons (Male 8,974 (58%) and Females 6,608 (42%) reached with Routine Immunization, and Surveillance messages. No case of suspected AFP found during the active case search. Regarding Capacity building on Routine Immunization and Surveillance a total of 288 persons (Males 227 (79%) and females 61 (21%). The Community Mobilizers detected three cases of AFP
