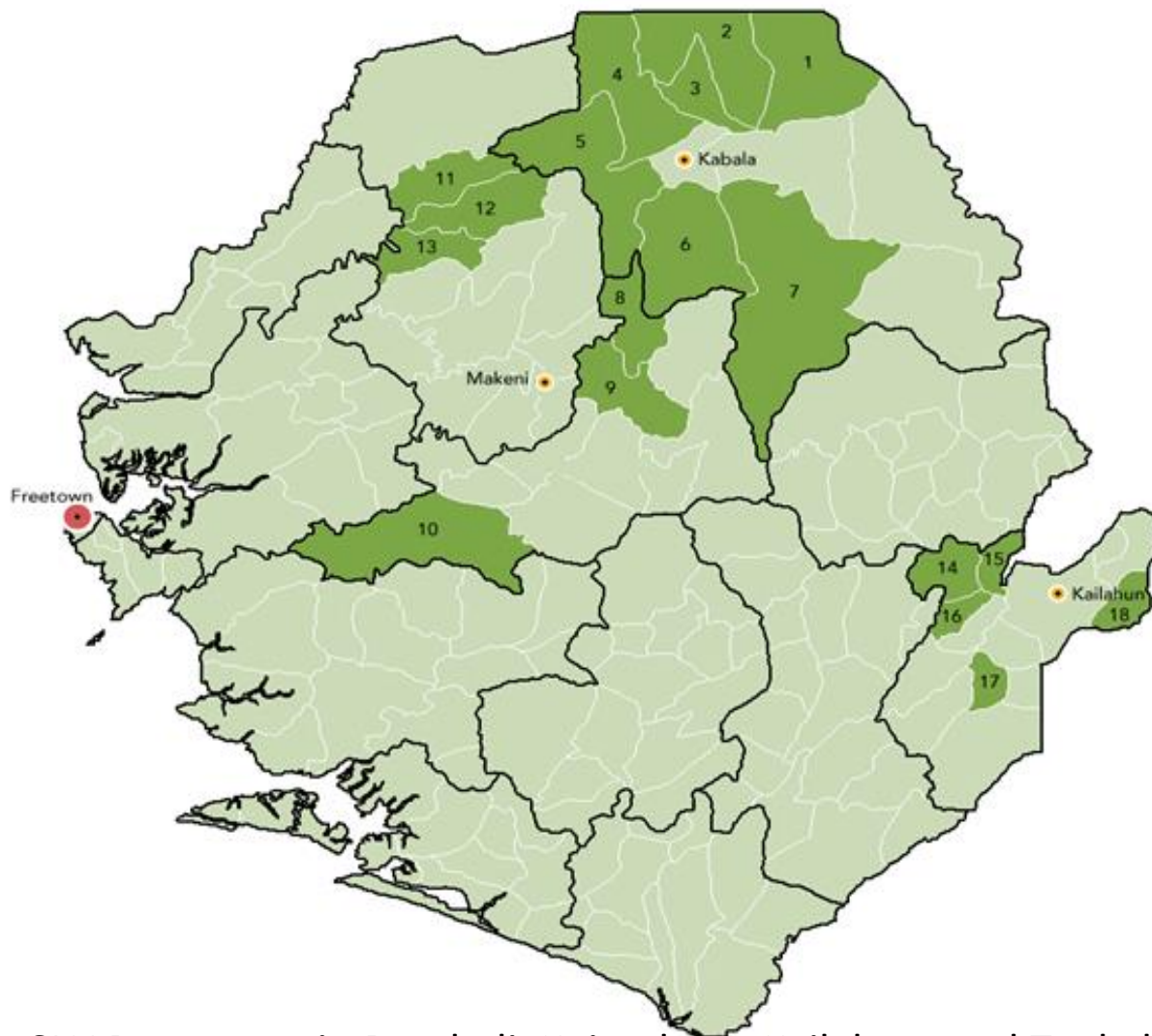
- ❑ Funding from USAID/Food for Peace

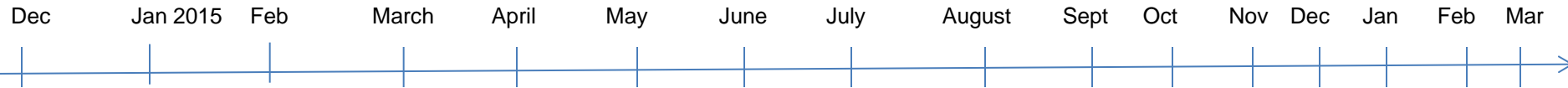

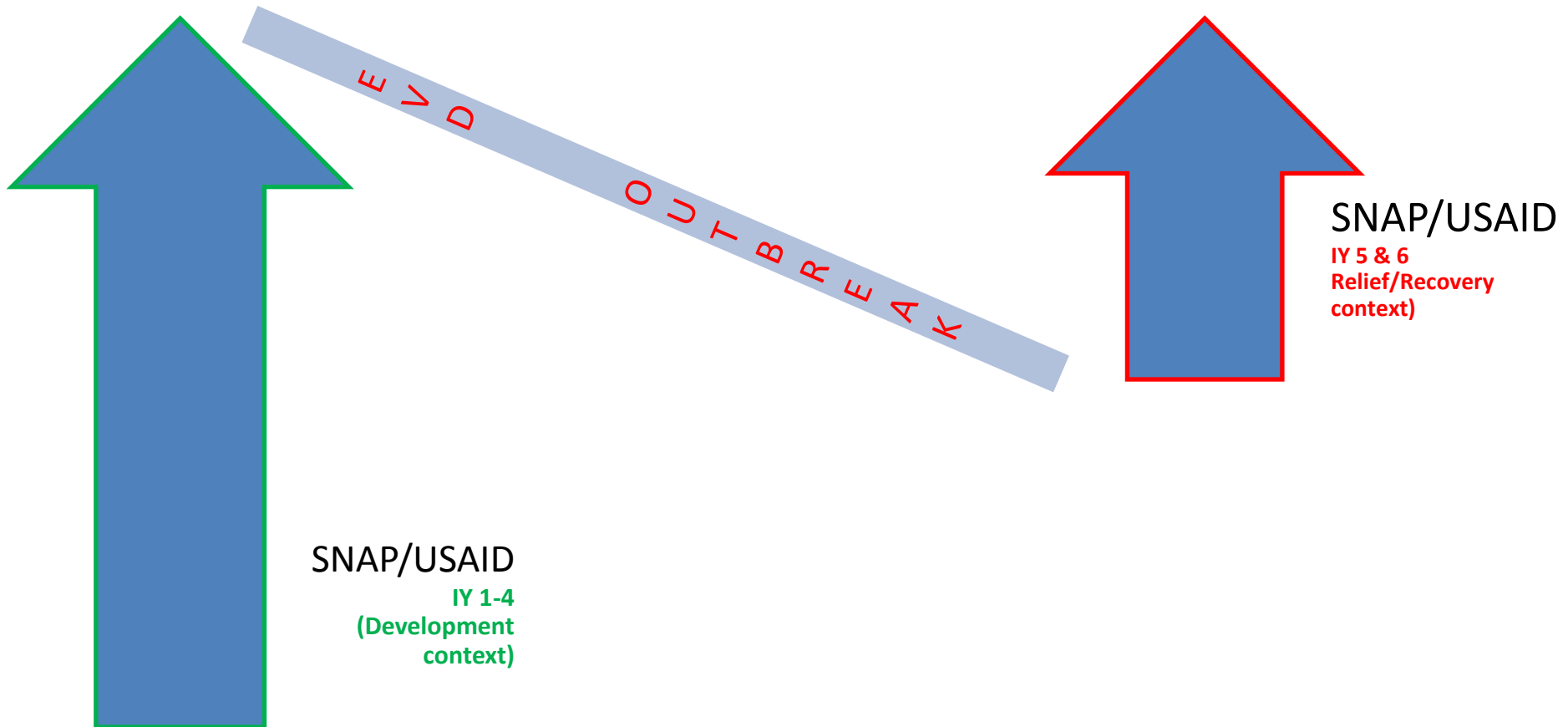

SO1 will build on the existing SNAP/USAID systems/structures



SO1 SNAP EVD activities and level of efforts

National level: GoSL MOHS, Line ministries
NERC :Soc Mob pillar – Ebola response
(Policies/protocols/strategies)

1. DHMT: Capacity building for supportive supervision.
2. Coordination and collaboration at district level with UN agencies, IMC/Ebola response etc

1. Reactivate Care Groups (with additional module including EVD comprehensive module)
2. IMAM, self assessment etc
3. Functional WASH & health committees promoting EVD IPC
4. Rehabilitation of WASH facilities at PHUs: hand washing, latrines, incinerators.
5. Capacity building and promotion of BPEHNS at PHUs, psychosocial and mental support, WASH etc. Provision of BPEs
6. Social Mobilization activities
7. Working with local men as partners / FINE-SL
8. Child Protection: EVD survivors
