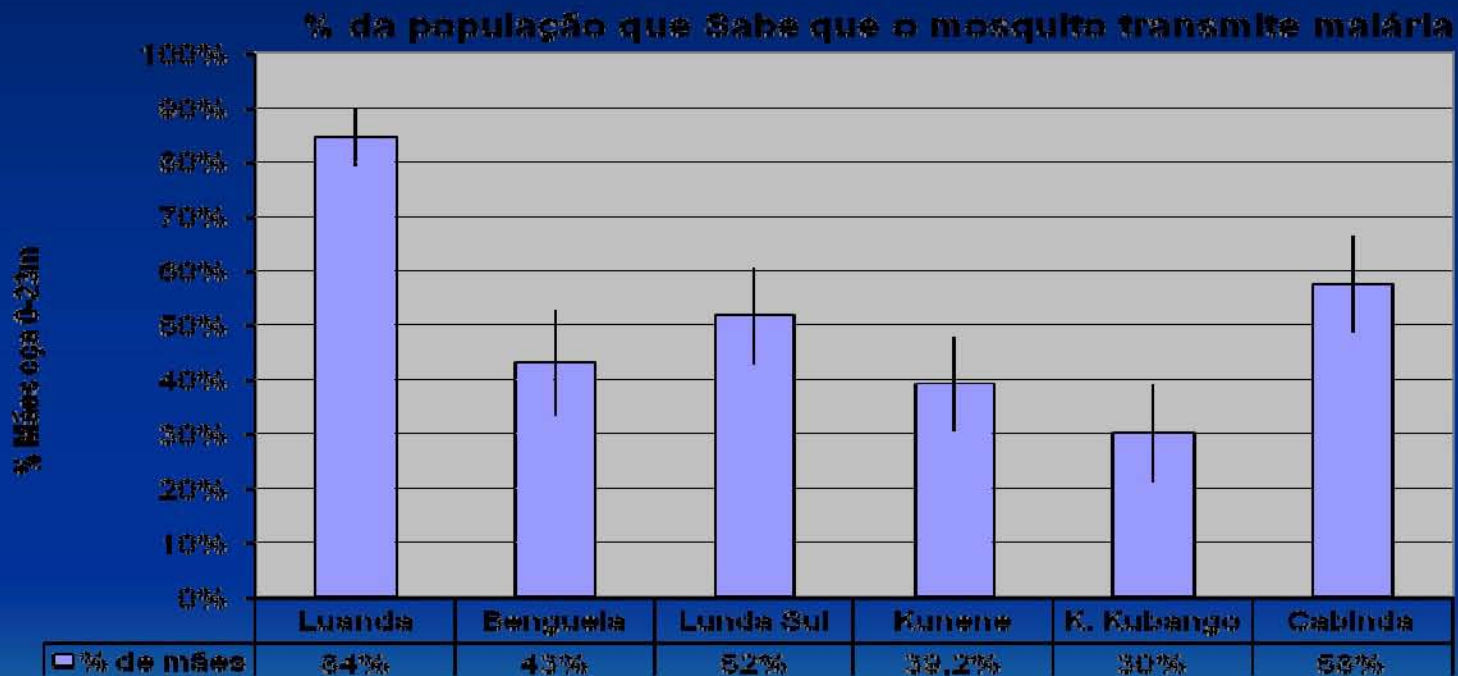
KNOWLEDGE

(Hamset, Unicef, Médicos Mundi, PSI, CV, Consaúde, CCF and Africare)



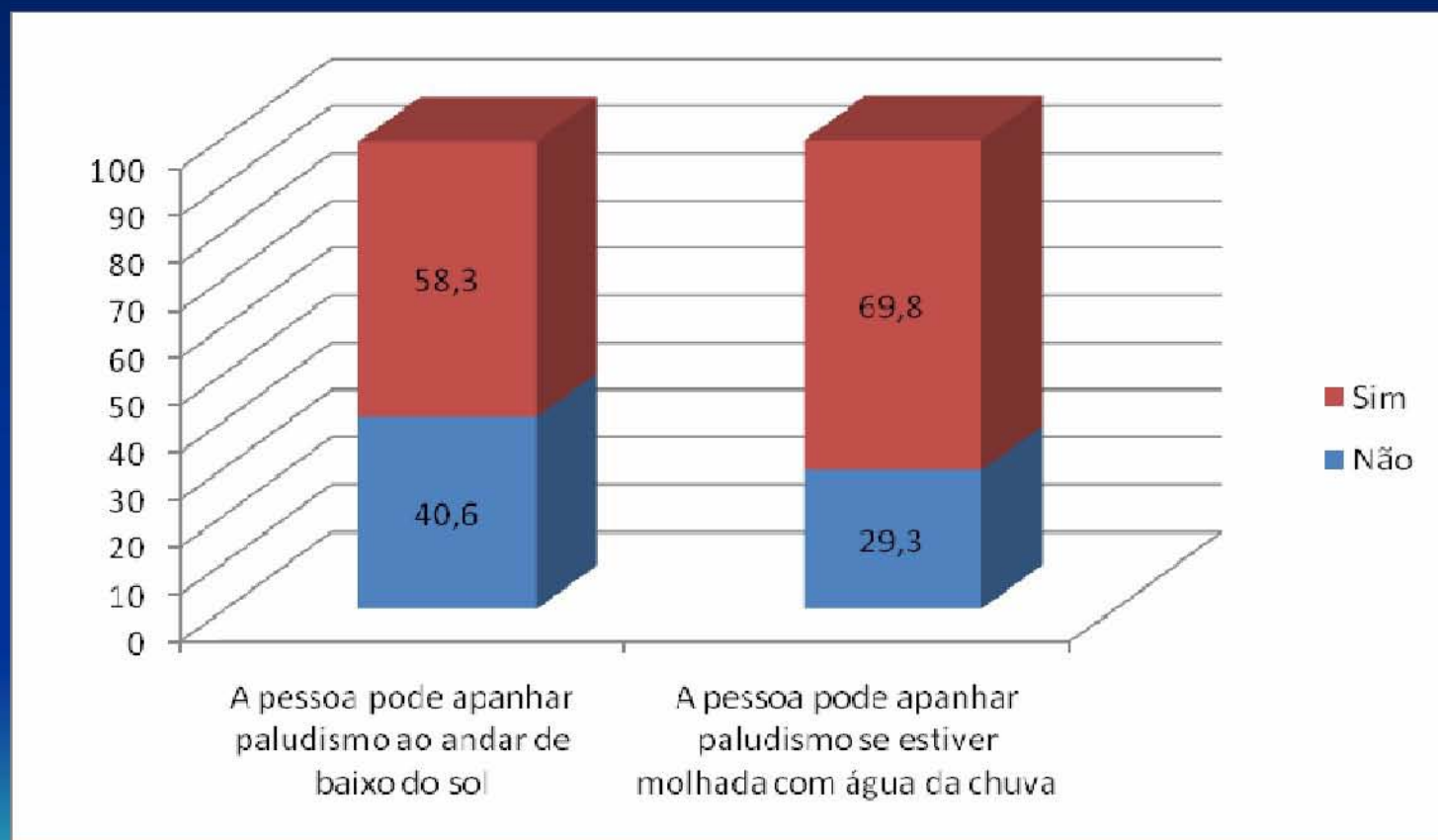
CAP. Transmission of Malaria?

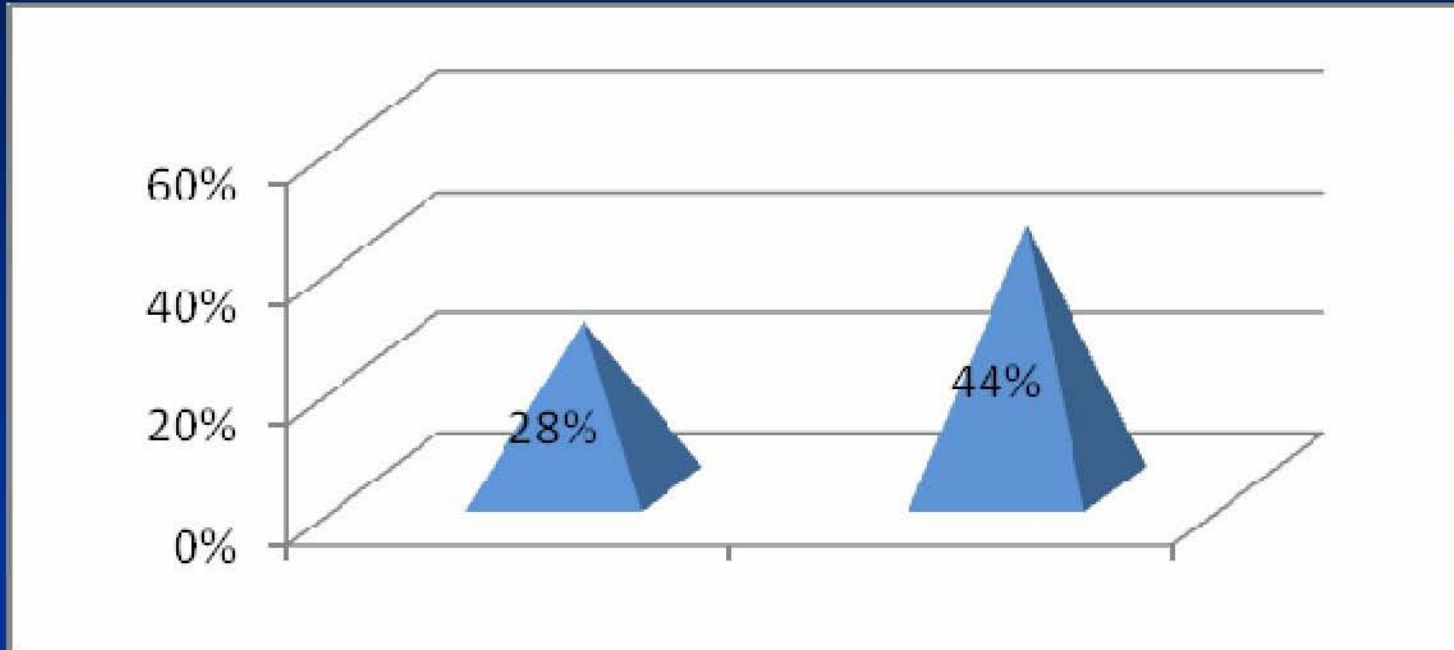
Knowledge: The Sun transmits malaria?

14 provinces



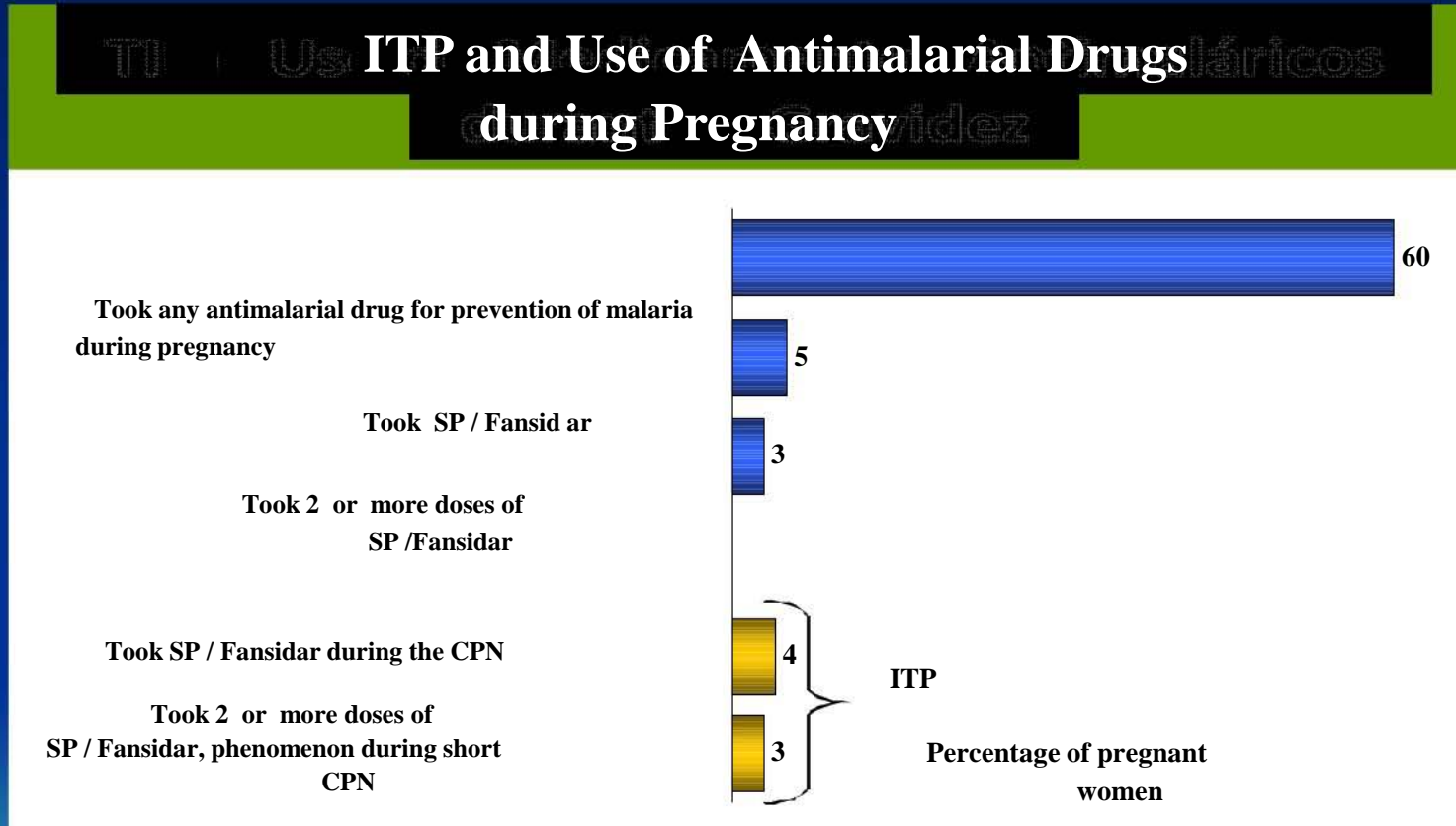
Attitude: Look for the Health Centre for treatment?

44% after 24 hours

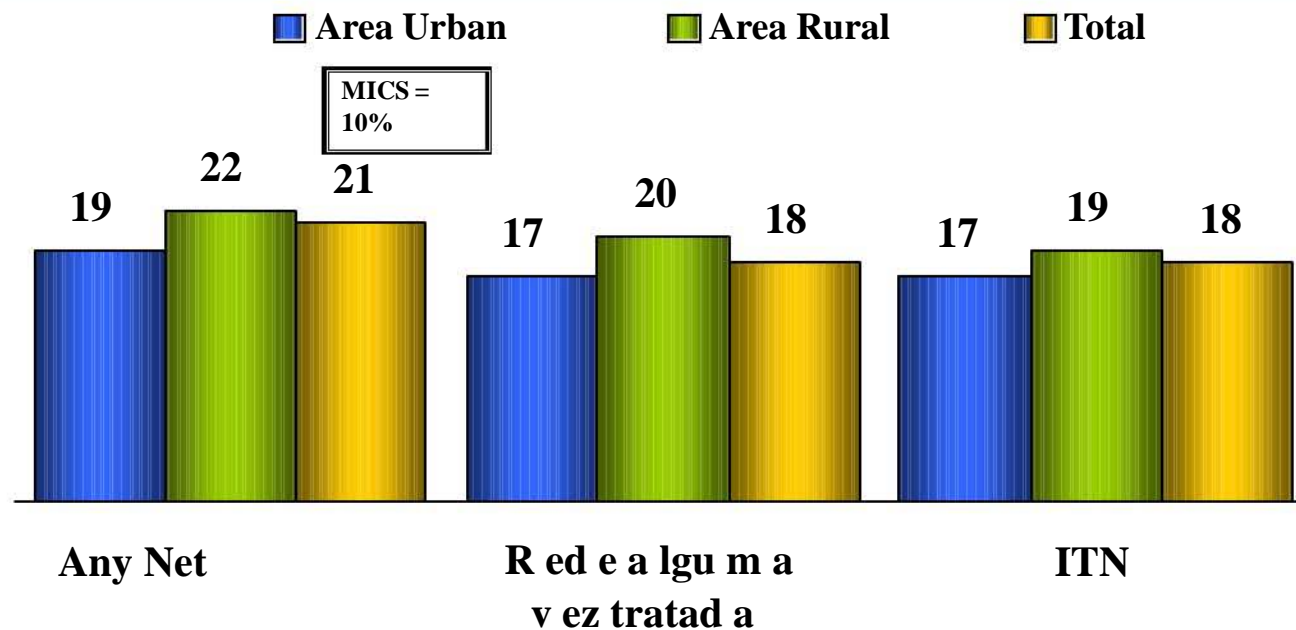
ATTITUDE: Intermittent Preventive Treatment of Malaria ITP

Use of Mosquito Nets in Children under the age of 5-years

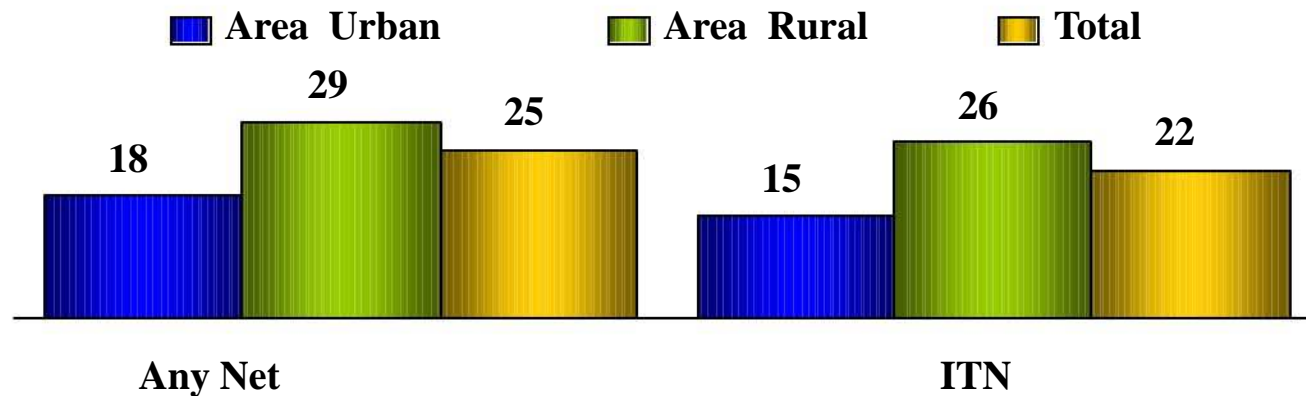
